

Enviro News:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) launched the Hazardous Waste Electronic Manifest System (e-Manifest) on June 30, 2018. Authorized by the 2012 e-Manifest Act, the e-Manifest system enables electronic tracking of hazardous wastes and will serve as a national reporting hub and database for all hazardous waste manifests and shipment data.
