Enviro News:

On December 11, 2018, the EPA and Department of the Army signed a proposed rule revising the definition of "waters of the United States" to clarify federal authority under the Clean Water Act. The agencies' proposal is the second step in a two-step process to review and revise the definition of "waters of the United States". The proposed definition would replace the approach in the 2015 Rule and the pre-2015 regulations.
